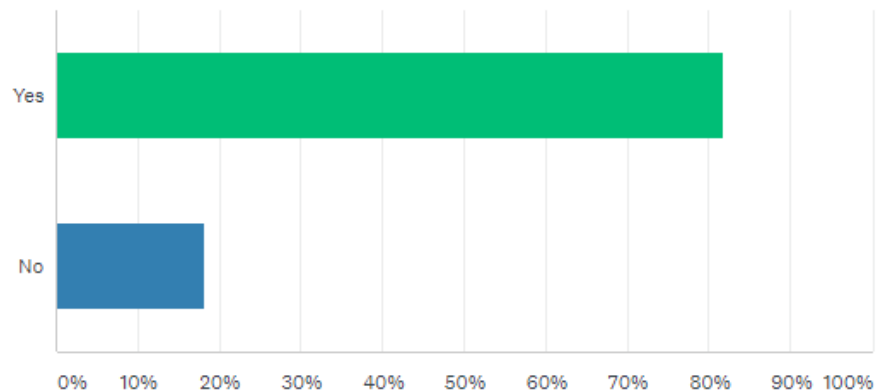


FADVS Meal Ticket Review

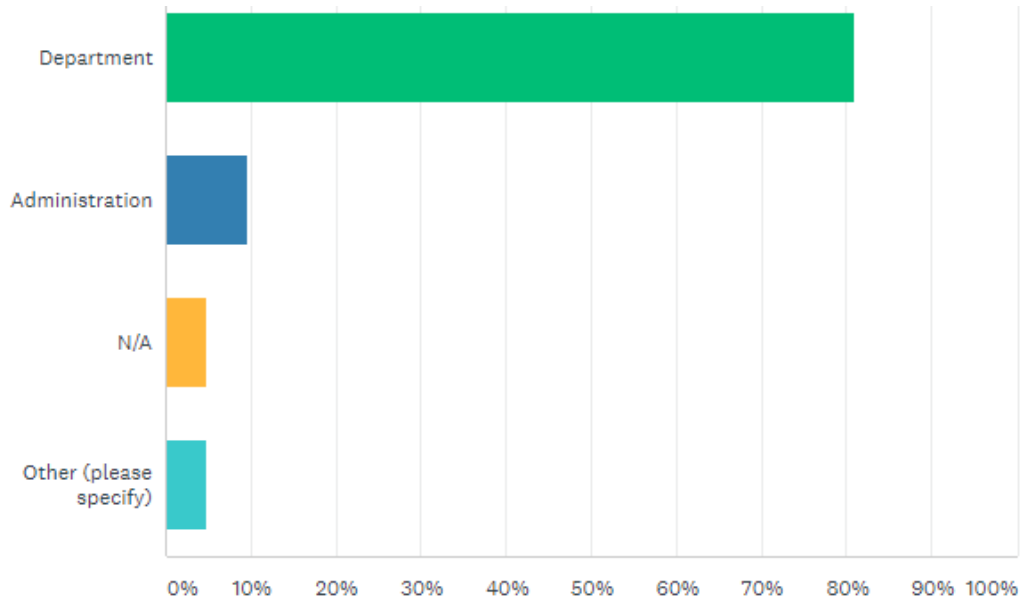

7. Are there any restrictions placed on your meal tickets? For example- restricted items that may be purchased, an expiration date, limits regarding how many items can be purchased at one time with the meal ticket credits, etc.? If so, please explain.

- No restrictions, the volunteer needs to have their badge and be in uniform and if they go over, they must cover the difference
- Volunteer use only. Cannot be transferred to anyone else. One time use only. If \$7 is exceeded, volunteer must pay balance.
- We expect them to use the ticket on the day they are volunteering. They cannot save them for different days. The tickets are only good for our own cafeteria, not in Subway, gift shop or any other entities in the building.
- Is applied to what they want if over this amount must be paid by volunteer
- no packaged items, no bottled drinks
- Name badges are used for up to \$5.50 per day, Meal tickets are used for extended shifts, student volunteers, other situations. They are stamped for the day only/can only be used once, not cumulative (can't buy a cup of coffee and then reuse the ticket for a bag of chips later)
- one ticket at a time and only food items. tickets may be used for food in our gift shop as well.
- Volunteers cannot use meal ticket to pay for bottled drinks
- At Health First, we do not supply meals for volunteers but we do have meal tickets for recognition. Free soda & coffee for volunteers while on duty is charged to volunteer services. HF Volunteers do enjoy a hospital inpatient or observation patient cost savings of 50% of their responsibility in HF hospitals only.
- No limits other than dollar amount and must be used in cafeteria - not valid at restaurants on campus.
- Volunteers must be wearing name badge to redeem. Can only redeem one ticket per day they volunteer. All tickets are serial numbered so we can track and reconcile. New Process - we had to estimate the number of meals we would provide in 2018 and then pre-pay for the tickets. All tickets expire on 12/31/2018.
- We don't use tickets, volunteers use their badges to scan at the register. no restrictions are in place.
- If they get a ticket it is good for 1 week
- Volunteers do not receive an actual voucher. The cashiers recognize them in their uniform with name badge and take \$7.00 off their bill. The only item restricted is sushi as that comes from a different vendor. Volunteer Services always has free water, soda, snacks and candy available in our department for volunteers. Many grab those items instead of using the \$7 meal credit.
